SHOW PRECINCTS:

The precincts of this show will be 15 feet from the outdoor ring and all facilities reserved for the exclusive use of the show-giving Club, excluding the parking lot.

YEARLING SWEEPSTAKES:

Classes: 6-9 months, Male/Female; 9-12 months, Male/Female; 12-18 months Male/Female
 Dogs must be entered in a regular class in the Specialty Show. Spayed and neutered dogs are NOT eligible to compete. The winner of each class will compete for Best in Sweeps. Prizes: after a 25% deduction for expenses, 50% of the remaining entry fees will be awarded proportionately (depending on the number of entries in the class). The remaining 50% will be divided between Best in Sweepstakes (60%) and the Runner Up to Best in Sweeps (40%).

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES:

Classes: 7-9 Years Male/Female, 10-12 Years Male/Female, 12 Years and Over Male/Female.
 Dogs must be entered in a regular class in the Specialty or for Exhibition Only. Spayed and neutered dogs are eligible to compete. Awards same as above.

ALTERED SWEEPSTAKES:

Classes: Altered Males, Altered Females For any spayed/neutered dog over six months of age. Must be entered in regular class in the Specialty (Altered, Veteran) or Exhibition Only. The winner of each class will compete for Best in Sweeps and Runner Up To Best In Sweeps. Awards same as above

SPECIALTY CLASSES:

The following regular classes (divided by sex) will be provided:
 JUNIOR PUPPY (6 - 9 Mths) BRED BY EXHIBITOR
 SENIOR PUPPY (9 - 12 Mths) OPEN
 YEARLING (12 - 18 Mths) VETERANS (may be spayed/neutered)
 CANADIAN BRED SPECIALS ONLY

CANADIAN BRED CLASS shall be for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR shall be for dogs owned and handled by the breeder.

VETERANS CLASS shall be for dogs 7 years of age or older. Spayed and neutered dogs MAY compete.

ALTERED OPEN CLASS: for all surgically neutered/spayed dogs will be offered. Awards include Winners Altered, Reserve Winners Altered, Best of Breed Altered and Best Opposite Sex Altered. Points may not be carried over into these classes from the regular competition judging. Classes will be judged immediately following the Regular breed classes.

EXHIBITION ONLY: catalog listing only. No dog entered in this class can compete for any regular class, however may be entered and compete in any non-regular class.

Dogs entered in the non-regular classes must also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only, except for Stud and Dam whose progeny MUST be entered in a regular class. Spayed and neutered dogs may be entered but must also be entered in the Altered Classes, Veteran Classes, or Exhibition Only.

The following Non-Regular classes will be provided

STUD DOG: for any sire and 2 or more of his get. Sire and get need not be owned by the same person. Class to be judged on the merits of the get.

DAM: same as above for any dam and 2 or more of her progeny.

BRACE: for 2 dogs shown by one person on one leash, do **NOT** need identical ownership.

COURSING CLASS: for any dog with a CKC, ASFA or AKC Field Championship.

TROPHIES:

Prizes will be offered for: BOB, BOS, BOW, Puppy, WD, WB, RW, 1st in Veterans, Brace, Sire, Dam, Coursing Class, BOB Altered, Winners and Reserve Altered. LMWA offers a perpetual trophy to the winner of BOB, BOS and Best Veteran. One Award of Merit may be given for every ten (10) dogs entered in competition for BOB.

RULES GOVERNING THIS SHOW:

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Superintendent shall have full control of these shows which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. Any dog excused by the superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not compete for the balance of the show.
3. Dogs should be on the grounds one hour prior to the judging of their breed. The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
4. Dogs must be on leash at all times on the show grounds. Crates/xpens are allowed at ringside but must be kept 15 feet from the ring.
5. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, spectators or vendors.
6. If because of civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no entries will be refunded.
7. All exhibitors, handlers and patrons are expected to know and abide by the CKC Show Rules.

EXTRACTS FROM CKC DOG SHOWS RULES

CHAPTER 8 Section 4.1.3 - JUDGES

A Judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

CHAPTER 13 - ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEES

Section 2. Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these Rules must be registered, or eligible for registration in the CKC. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC, it may be entered in a show held under these rules as a "listed" dog, provided a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed, b) if born in Canada, is eligible for registration in the records of the CKC. The entry of a "listed" dogs at a show held under these Rules must be accompanied by a listing fee.

CHAPTER 8 Section 8.6.2 DISHONOURERED CHEQUES

Tendering of a dishonoured cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitors who have been known to tender dishonoured cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order or certified cheque.

CHAPTER 14 Section 14.1.4- DISQUALIFICATION

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action.

CHAPTER 5 Section 5.1.5 SHOW OFFICIALS

A show-giving Club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent

All entries must be complete, signed and must be submitted on the current official CKC entry form (back side of form not required). Entries submitted in any other size or format will be rejected. Telephone entries are not accepted. Incomplete or conditional entries, entries received without full entry fees or valid credit card numbers, or entries received by the Show Secretary after the advertised closing date/time will not be accepted. There will be no refund on overpayment or duplicate entries. Please type or print legibly in black ink, especially when faxing. It is recommended you phone after submitting entries via fax to ensure the transmission was complete and legible.

FAX & CREDIT CARD ENTRIES :

Fax entries and Credit Card payment will be accepted when accompanied by an authorized Credit Card Number. \$3.00 per entry will be added for fax/credit card entries. Customers whose charges are declined by Bank Card authorization departments will be assessed \$15 for each transaction declined. It is recommended you phone after submitting fax entries to confirm they were received.

NOTE – charges on your statement will be to **COMPUPETS INTERNET INC.**

ATTENTION U.S. EXHIBITORS:

Foreign born and foreign owned dogs may compete with an **Event Registration Number (ERN)**. This must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation and can be obtained by submitting a copy of your foreign certificate of registration and a fee of \$58.85 with a letter of request to the CKC. This ERN replaces a CKC individual registration number for entering events only. NOTE: a CKC Listing Fee of \$9.10 is payable for each entry that does NOT include the CKC Individual Registration Number or ERN (Event Registration Number for US owned dogs).

Border crossing – A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada and upon return to the USA. Government regulations require a certificate and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada. The border is extremely busy this time of year – allow plenty of time for border crossing. **EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2009** ALL US citizens returning to the USA will be required to produce an Enhanced Driver's License, Passport, Passport Card, or Nexus Card when re-entering the USA. To avoid delays in your return home, please ensure you have one of the above documents with you on your trip to Canada.

Current exchange rates between Canadian & U S dollars have been fluctuating considerably. USA exhibitors should purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds for the full amount of the entry. Personal cheques drawn on a U S bank will be accepted, however they must be payable for the full amount of the entry fee(s).
