

FAX & CREDITS CARD ENTRIES:

Fax entries and credit card payment will be accepted when accompanied by an authorized credit card number. \$3.00 per entry will be added for fax/credit card entries. Customers whose charges are declined by Bank Card authorization departments will be assessed \$15 for each transaction declined. It is recommended you phone after submitting fax entries to confirm they were received. **Your credit card statement will show a charge to COUNTRY TIRE.**

ATTENTION U.S. EXHIBITORS:

Current Exchange rates are favoring the USD. We will accept personal cheques, however, they must be payable in US funds for the full amount of the entry. Please do NOT mark personal cheques "payable in Canadian funds". Your cooperation is appreciated.

Foreign born and foreign owned dogs may compete with an **Event Registration Number (ERN)**. This must be obtained within 30 days of first entry and can be obtained by submitting a copy of your foreign certificate of registration and a fee of \$58.85 with a letter of request to the CKC. This ERN replaces a CKC individual registration number for entering events only. A CKC Listing Fee of \$8.40 per dog is payable for each dog that does NOT include the CKC Individual Registration Number or ERN (Event Registration Number for US owned dogs).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- *A limited food concession will be available at the show site.
- *Border crossing – A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require a certificate and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada
- *The LMWA will be holding a Whippet Specialty on Saturday and a CKC Lure Field Trial for Whippets, followed by a Field Trial CKC Conformation Specialty Show on Sunday, July 5th at Fraser River Heritage Park in Mission. Contact LMWA at 604-856-5660, LMWA@shaw.ca for information and entries.

SHOW PRECINCTS:

The precincts of this show will be 15 feet from the outdoor ring and all facilities reserved for the exclusive use of the show-giving Club, excluding the parking lot.

YEARLING SWEEPSTAKES:

Classes: 6-9 months, Male/Female; 9-12 months, Male/Female; 12-18 months Male/Female
 Dogs must be entered in a regular class in the Specialty Show. Spayed and neutered dogs are NOT eligible to compete. The winner of each class will compete for Best in Sweeps. Prizes: after a 25% deduction for expenses, 50% of the remaining entry fees will be awarded proportionately (depending on the number of entries in the class). The remaining 50% will be divided between Best in Sweepstakes (60%) and the Runner Up to Best in Sweeps (40%).

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES:

Classes: 7-9 Years Male/Female, 10-12 Years Male/Female, 12 Years and Over Male/Female.
 Dogs must be entered in a regular class in the Specialty or for Exhibition Only. Spayed and neutered dogs are eligible to compete. Awards same as above.

ALTERED SWEEPSTAKES:

Classes: Altered Males, Altered Females For any spayed/neutered dog over six months of age. Must be entered in regular class in the Specialty (Altered, Veteran) or Exhibition Only. The winner of each class will compete for Best in Sweeps and Runner Up To Best In Sweeps. Awards same as above

BREEDERS' SWEEPSTAKES:

For any dog over 6 months of age, handled in the ring by the breeder but need not be owned by the breeder. Classes will be divided by sex. Must be entered in regular class in the Specialty (Altered, Veteran) or Exhibition Only.

NOTE: Unfortunately we are unable to offer "on-line entries" at this time. You entries will need to be faxed, mailed or hand delivered. **Credit Card charges will show to Country Tire.**

SPECIALTY CLASSES:

The following regular classes (divided by sex) will be provided:
 JUNIOR PUPPY (6 - 9 Mths) BRED BY EXHIBITOR
 SENIOR PUPPY (9 - 12 Mths) OPEN
 YEARLING (12 - 18 Mths) VETERANS (may be spayed/neutered)
 CANADIAN BRED SPECIALS ONLY

CANADIAN BRED CLASS for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.
 BRED BY EXHIBITOR for dogs owned and handled by the breeder.
 VETERANS CLASS for dogs 7 years of age or older. Spayed/ neutered dogs MAY compete.

ALTERED OPEN CLASS: for all surgically neutered/spayed dogs will be offered. Awards include Winners Altered, Reserve Winners Altered, Best of Breed Altered and Best Opposite Sex Altered. Points may not be carried over into these classes from the regular competition judging. Classes will be judged immediately following the Regular breed classes.

EXHIBITION ONLY: catalog listing only. No dog entered in this class can compete for any regular class, however may be entered and compete in any non-regular class.
 Dogs entered in the non-regular classes must also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only, except for Stud and Dam whose progeny MUST be entered in a regular class. Spayed/neutered dogs may be entered but must also be entered in the Altered Classes, Veteran Classes, or Exhibition Only.

The following Non-Regular classes will be provided
 STUD DOG: for any sire and 2 or more of his get. Sire and get need not be owned by the same person. Class to be judged on the merits of the get.
 DAM: same as above for any dam and 2 or more of her progeny.
 EXTENDED GENERATION: for any dog shown with 2 or 3 direct consecutive descendents
 BRACE: for 2 dogs shown by one person on one leash, do **NOT** need identical ownership.
 COURSING CLASS: for any dog with a CKC, ASFA or AKC Field Championship.
 RACING CLASS: for any dog with a R.CH., ORC, or ARX
